07. VERSE VIRTUOSOS: CELEBRATING YOUNG POETS AT PPS

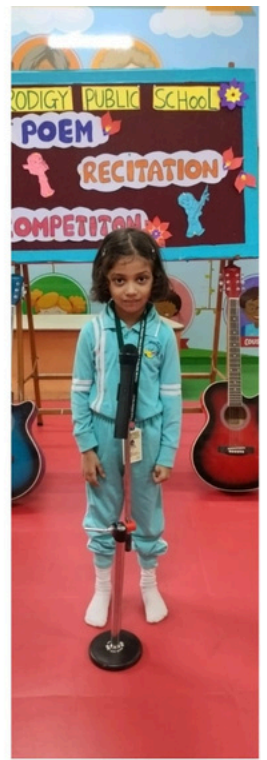
